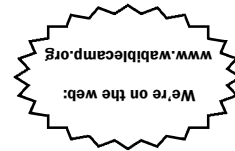

John 3:16 was the first Bible verse I memorized when I became a believer in Jesus Christ. This verse and others that followed showed me clearly that I was a lost sinner and I needed a Saviour. I understood my lost condition when I understood the clear meaning of God's Holy Word.

Imagine if you were trying to hear God's precious news in another language? Did you understand the verse above? Imagine now, how many Hispanic people are here in the United States right now that cannot read English and barely understand it. Right now in North West Arkansas, there is an estimated 30,000 Spanish speaking individuals that need to hear a clear presentation of the gospel. Today, there is no Spanish speaking church in Harrison, Arkansas, and yet there are 25 Hispanic families living here with more moving to this area.

Mid America Mission has a burden for these precious people that Jesus loves and has commanded us to go and preach the gospel to. MAM is seeking a Hispanic pastor to come and Shepard the Spanish people in Harrison, AR. There are several American churches that are willing to help with prayer, materials, volunteer help, and even finances, to help MAM get this great commissioned work growing. In the meantime, MAM will be working closely with the Spanish people until a Spanish pastor can be found. If you would like to help, please use the enclosed envelope to send us your gift. Please pray with us as we endeavor to reach the least and the last of the lost, with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

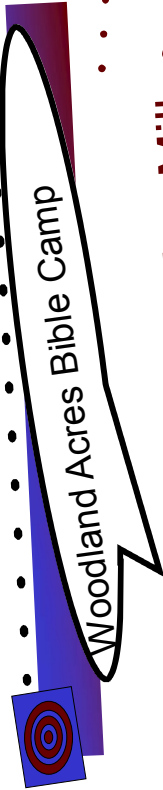

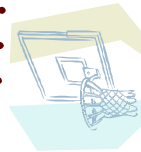
